Dear Parents/Caregivers,

K – 6 DANCE PROGRAM 2024

Our Dance Program will commence in Term 2 and run the duration until our Bi Annual Dance Concert which is being held on Tuesday 3 December, 2024. This dance program will be taught by a qualified dance teacher. Dance and movement at a young age is a great way for children to explore movement through music, develop physical skills, channel energy, stimulate imagination, enhance problem solving skills and promote creativity. Students will participate in the program which fulfills the Physical Education, Health and Creative Arts outcome requirements for all students K-6.

All schools across the state received one-off funding for wellbeing initiatives through the Commonwealth's Student Wellbeing Boost. The Student Wellbeing Boost supports schools to respond to the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic and successive lockdowns on the mental health and wellbeing of their students. Through this department initiative, we have decided to utilise these funds to supplement our existing whole school Dance Program Initiative.

COST: \$35.00 per student for 3 Terms (non-refundable)

Students will be required to wear their sports uniform on their allocated day. The cost of the program is \$35.00 student for the duration of the program, including concert costumes.

Please note your child's attendance is optional. If your child is not available for the day of the concert, please advise their classroom teacher and dance teacher so the class dance choreography can be altered accordingly. However, they will still participate in weekly lessons.

In order for your child to participate in this learning experience, please complete the online consent and ensure payment is made by Friday 3 May, 2024.
