Dear Parents/Caregivers

YEARS 5 & 6 REQUIREMENTS – 2023

Welcome to Years 5 and 6, 2023. The students will be required to purchase from school, their textbooks and exercise books, which maintain correct line size for each age group. This will appear on your Term 1 family account.

Children will be required to bring the following items:

- 1 x USB 8GB (recommended) flash drive clearly labelled with child's name
- 1 x pkt coloured pencils
- 1 x pkt coloured textas
- 1 x 10-pack of quality HB lead pencils
- 2 x small white erasers (Staedtler)
- 1 x barrel sharpener
- 1 x 30cm rigid plastic or wooden ruler with millimetre markings
- 1 x **small** pencil case for lead pencils, glue, erasers, etc
- 1x **larger** pencil case for textas, pencils, calculator, etc
- 4 x red ball point pens – not felt tip
- 4 x blue ball point pens – not felt tip
- 2 x Artline 700 (0.7mm) black permanent marker for artwork
- 1 x black sharpie fine point
- 1 x tissue box
- 1 x liquid soap
- 2 x paper towel rolls
- 6 x glue sticks
- Earbuds for computer/iPad/library work. Please place in a container clearly labelled
- Highlighters – set of four different colours
- 1 x pair of scissors
- 2 x 128pg A4 exercise book for homework – covered in your choice of contact, clearly labelled with your child's name
- 1 x Senior Australian Dictionary
- 1 x Thesaurus
- 1 x calculator (**NOT Scientific**)
- 1 x geometry set (protractor and compass)
- A4 clipboard
- 2 x correction tape (not liquid)
- A paint shirt (old adult t-shirts are suitable)
- 1 x Spray and Wipe (girls)
- 1 packet of Chux (boys)

Please assist us by ensuring **all equipment is marked with your child's name**. It is important all equipment is at school and maintained in working order for use each day. These supplies will need to be replenished as they run out.
